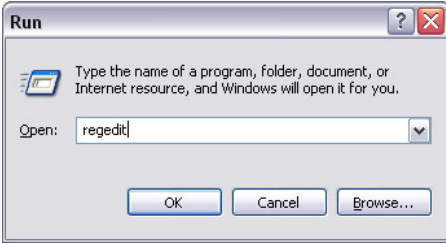
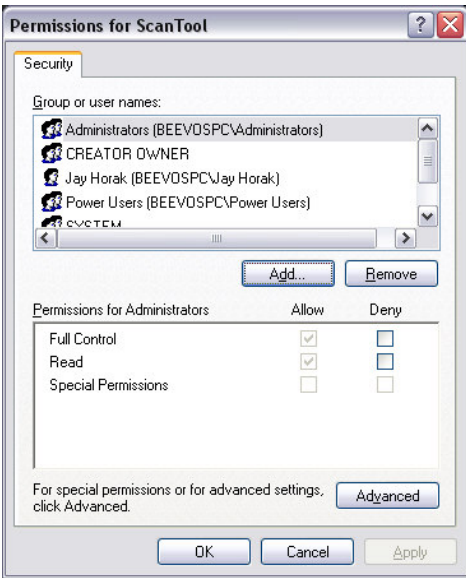


- Open WINDOWS EXPLORER (Start-All Programs-Accessories-Windows Explorer)
- Navigate to C:\Program Files\AutoEnginuity\ScanTool
- Right click on the ScanTool file (right side of Explorer, with the AutoEnginuity logo on the left)
- Select "Run As..." or "Run As Administrator" Click OK
- Give Windows permission (and permission to the program) to access your computer
- The ScanTool will open then click on Vehicle|Communications Configuration
- DISABLE "Automatically Connect on Launch" and then Close the ScanTool program
- On your keyboard, find the key that has the "Windows" logo
- Press it, and while keeping it down and type a single letter "R" and Release the "Windows" logo key.
- In the small window that opens, type regedit as shown below and click "Run".



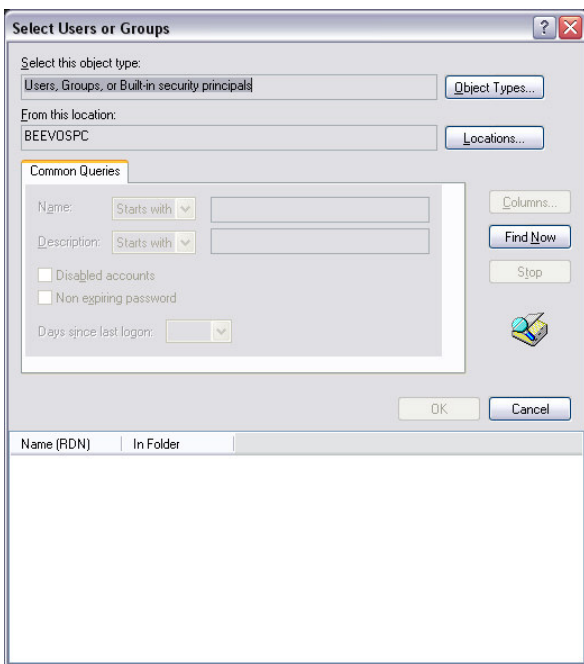
- A window titled "Registry Editor" will be displayed.
- Windows 7 will ask if "you want to allow the program to make changes to the computer", answer YES
- On the left side of the registry, single click on the very first item (My Computer, or Computer), so it appears highlighted
- Click on Edit-Find, and type "Activation Code" (without the quotation marks) in the space provided
- Click "Find Next"
- Once found, make sure that the folder that shows open on the left reads "ScanTool"
- On the right side, single click on "Activation Code"
- Once it is highlighted, press the "Delete" key on your keyboard
- If prompted by Windows, Click on "Yes", to delete the entry
- Right click on "ScanTool" (left side of the registry), and select "Permissions"



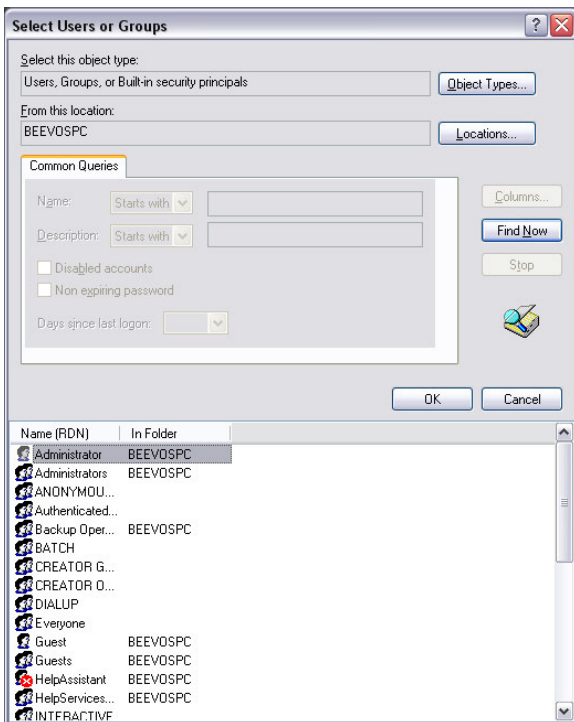
- Between the top and bottom windows, click on "Add"



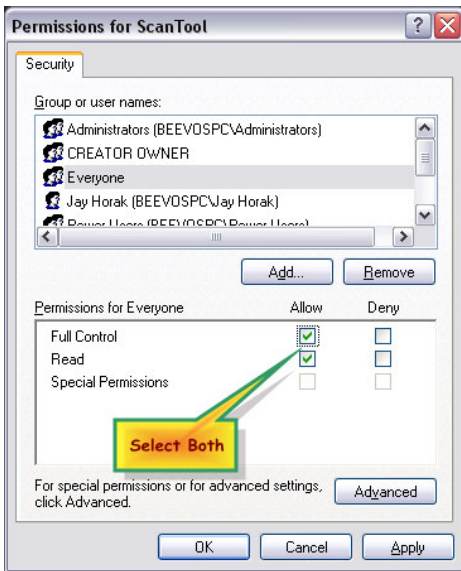
- On the bottom, left corner, click on "Advanced..."



- On the right side, click on "Find Now"



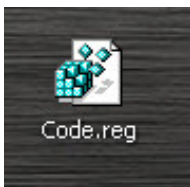
- From the list of users that appear in the list, click on "Everyone"
- Click "OK" and then Click "OK"



- While "Everyone" is highlighted in the top window, click on the box next to "Full Control", under the "Allow" column
- Click "Apply"
- Repeat the previous 8 steps selecting "INTERACTIVE" this time
- Minimize the Registry Editor
- Open the ScanTool program
- Enter the activation code in the spaces provided in the Feature Activation window.
- This window can be found under Help-Feature Activation-Activate.
- Click OK to the message "ScanTool must be restarted to enable any activation codes."
- Close the software.
- Restart the software and check that the activations are saved.

If you wish to save the Registry Entry for AutoEnginuity, perform the following tasks. This will allow you to restore the activations with just a few clicks.

- Go back to the Registry Editor
- At the top of the registry editor, click File-Export.
- Click on the icon that reads "Desktop", on the left side of the Window that appeared.
- In the filename field, type "Code" (without the quotation marks).
- Click "Save".
- Close the registry editor.



- On your desktop, there will be a new icon that reads "Code". The icon looks like ice cubes.
- Double click on the icon.
- If you get a message from Windows, click Continue, Next, or OK, until those messages disappear.
- Open the ScanTool program, and go to Help-Feature Activation. Make sure that the enhancements you have purchased appear on Green, displaying "Activated".
- Close that Window, and connect to a vehicle.
